Treasurer's Report

- 10. Three youths climbed the fence at the pool to get a drink of water. The incident escalated and the police were called. The youths were released to their parents/guardians.
- 11. The phone for the gate security has not been shut off as a contact for the company has not reestablished.
- 12. Leigh Ann O has obtained all South Fork relative material from Dan.

Old Business

- 1. The mowing contract is due for renewal. Leigh Ann O is going to get a couple bids.
- 2. We discussed changes to the By-laws and covenants. The method of approving any changes was discussed. The timing of such changes was discussed.
